History

As historians we will develop our chronology knowledge to understand when and why space exploration happened. Discovering pioneers such as Valentina Tereshkova and Neil Armstrong.

<u>Art</u>

As artists we will explore and draw. Be introduced to the idea that artists can be collectors and explorers as they develop drawing and composition skills. Artists: Andy Goldsworthy, Alex Fox, Nicola White.

Physical Education

Real PE: developing coordination through footwork and one leg static balances then dynamic balances to agility focusing on controlled jumping and landing, through themes of bikes, pirates, space and the jungle.

Real Dance: developing different shapes with our bodies.

Mathematics

As mathematicians we will build on our previous experiences counting within 100. Compare different quantities using more and less than as well as part whole models. Using numbers 0-5 we will partition, find missing parts and accurately use different representations to explain. We will begin to explore different 2D and 3D shapes.
